  - (Ms Saunders presented. Second grade classrooms participate annually with Barnstable county of Natural resources to help threatened species. Second graders get three turtles and share them with other classrooms. They are released at Sandy Neck marsh. It was discovered that there weren't a lot of books, non fictional, informational, for this age group. Ms Saunders and another teach self-published one themselves. The money would be used to give each student a book; this would be an annual line item for the PTA.)
